#### **Intent of these jottings**

To follow oue Master's example in our daily prayer.

#### Jesus Prayed at All Times

- Early in the morning (Mark 1:35) "Very early the next morning, long before daylight, Jeeps got up and left the house, He went out of the town to a lonely place where he prayed.
- <u>Late in the night</u> (*Luke 6:12*) At that time Jesus went up a hill to pray, and he spent the whole night there praying to God...
- Often during the day. (Luke 5:16) But he would go away to lonely places, where he prayed,

## And You, at What Times Do You Pray?

<u>In the morning?</u> Is prayer of such importance for you that, if need be, you will get up early in the morning to pray for a while?

<u>In the night?</u> Do you, however tired, spend some time at night praying before going to bed?

**During the day** Do you occasionally, during the day – wherever you may find yourself - spend some moments in prayer with God?

## Jesus Prayed at the Critical Moments of His life

- <u>Jesus prayed before starting his public life.</u> (*Luke 3:21/22*)" At His Baptism in the Jordan, Jesus prayed to God his Heavenly Father.
- <u>Jesus prayed before he started his public ministry</u> (*Mathew t 4/1-11*) For forty days and forty nights in the desert.
- Jesus prayed before he chose the apostles (Luke 6:12/13) "Jesus went up a hill to pray, when day came he called his disciples and chose twelve of them"
- <u>Jesus prayed before his transfiguration</u> (*Luke 9:28/29* ) Jesus took Peter, John and James with him and he went up a hill to pray".
- <u>Jesus prayed before the his Passion.</u> (*Luke 22:39-462* The prayer of Jesus in Garden of Olives.: No My will, but your will be done!.
- <u>Jesus prayed on the cross</u> (*Luke 23:34& 46*) "Forgive them, Father, They do not know what they do" "
- At the moment of his death: (Luke 23/46) Father, into your hands I place my spirit"

## And You, on What Occasions Do You Pray?

- > Do you pray in critical times?
- > When you have to take any important decision
- > Do your pray in your joys, successes and failures?
- > Do you turn to God, in prayer, in your sufferings difficulties and trials?

## **Jesus Prayed for Others?**

- (Luke 22-32) Jesus prays for Simon Peter that his faith may not fail.
- (John 17:9-16) Jesus, at the Last Super, prayed for his disciples
- (John 17:20) Jesus, at the Last Super, prayed for us all Christians-to-be
- (Luke 23:34) Jesus prayed for his enemies, all those responsible for his crucifixion.

#### And You, for Whom Do You Pray?

- ➤ Who do you pray for your family? For your in-laws, your servants and employees?
- > Do you pray for your friends and neighbors?
- > Do you pray for your enemies and those you dislike?
- ➤ Do you pray for the poor, the sick, the old, the exploited, the sinners, the children, the unemployed, the authorities? etc.
- ➤ Do you pray for the great general intentions like: for peace in the world, for the Church, for unity among peoples, for the propagation of the faith, etc. ?

#### **Closure:**

- Frame some sort of resolutions to improve your prayer life
- For awhile pray without prayers, pray just from your heart.
- Recite the Our Father.
- Read or sing an appropriate hymn.
